PRAYER GROUP

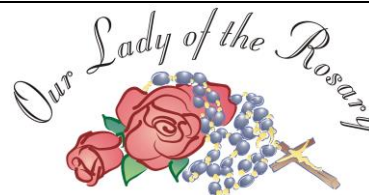

Seminarian Corner

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened." This invitation is one that can be extended to most, if not all people today. In the Gospel today, Jesus is showing us a way out of all of our struggles and burdens. All we must do is attach ourselves to Christ. Jesus invites us to take his yoke. Since there are not too many farms left here at Saint Pius X, let me give you the definition of the term yoke. A yoke is a wooden beam normally used between a pair of oxen to enable them to pull together cargo. My point being, that when we say we take on the yoke of Christ, we do not get off the hook. As disciples of Christ we must work with Him in order for labor and burdens to become light. We must form a bond with Jesus. It is not that our labor and pains become easier, but it is that our eyes of faith are opened, and we see them as a chance to grow in love with God and one another. This week as we go out into the community, let us team up with Christ and bring his love to all that we meet.
