She went on to have a wonderful year, evidenced by the stream of tears down her face on the last day. It is very true that you are loved at St. Pius X, but not just the students. Joey was just a baby, and Sr. June knew him already and always had a big smile and hug for him. As a family, it is more than a school-it's a community. Coming together for Mass on Sundays, we have come to find great friends. Family get-togethers such as movie night, the magic show and "Parents' Appreciation Day"- all help us feel loved as a family and know that we have our children in the right place. They will be able to grow as young individuals who will be confident in themselves, respect themselves and respect others because there is love.
