Birth Parents Must Take Action To Preserve Their Privacy

Birth parents must take action to preserve their privacy. On May 27, 2014, a new law took effect that will allow adoptees and certain relatives to request and obtain the names of their biological parents beginning January 1, 2017. Birth parents who wish to preserve their privacy must submit a redaction request form to the N.J. Department of Health by December 31, 2016.
