Fourth Annual Feast of Corpus Christi Food Collection For The Poor

Each summer our Catholic Charities Food Pantries experience severe shortages due to less food donations coming in over the summer and the greater need for food especially among children.

Hopefully, the Corpus Christi Food Collection For The Poor will alleviate the annual food shortage. Bishop Serratelli has authorized this Diocesan-wide food collection in all parishes on the ***Feast of Corpus Christi on the weekend of June 17th & 18th***.

Unlike most food drives in which parishioners are given a list of items to collect, for this special drive each parish is asked to collect two specific items. The reason for this is to assure we have sufficient quantities of each item. St. Pius X Parish has been asked to provide ***any kind of Canned Beans and Disinfectant Wipes (for example, Lysol or Clorox)***.

Religious Formation Registration for the new School Year will be completed on line again this year. An E Mail has been sent out to all Religious Formation Families. If you have not received the E Mail, that means we do not have a correct E Mail address for you. Please contact the Ministry House to update our records. Please make sure E Mail from St. Pius X does not go into your Spam Folder.

We continue to encourage all of our families to attend Sunday Liturgy and fully participate in the life of the parish. All families registered in the Religious Formation Program are required to be registered parishioners and financially supportive of the St. Pius X Parish.

How To Register On Line

1. Visit the parish website at www.st-pius-x.org.
2. Click on the *Religious Formation* tab at the top of the screen.
3. Click on the correct *Registration Form*.
4. If your family was part of our program last year, please click on *Re-Registration Form*.
5. If you are a new family registering for Religious Formation for the first time, please click on *The New Family Registration Form*.
6. Please complete the form.
7. Your registration will not be accepted without payment. The same company that handles Automated Giving for the parish handles the Registration Fees.

Holy Orders - Ordination Banns

Most of us are familiar with Wedding Banns appearing in our parish bulletin from time to time as couples prepare to celebrate the Sacrament of Christian Marriage. Much less common is the appearance of Ordination Banns. Whenever a parish is blessed to have a candidate for Holy Orders being presented for ordination as a deacon or priest, the local parish is asked to publish the customary Banns for two consecutive weekends in the bulletin. These banns are meant as a public announcement that helps assure that no impediments to Orders exist and as a public announcement of the upcoming, joyful celebration. Rev. Mr. Michal Dykalski, is scheduled to be ordained to the Order of Priesthood on Saturday, July 1, 2017, at St. John Cathedral by Bishop Serratelli. This is a public announcement of the upcoming ordination, and fulfills the canonical requirement. Catholics are obliged to reveal any impediments or circumstances that would prevent Rev. Mr. Dykalski from receiving Sacred Orders, and should contact the Pastor or the Bishop with such information as soon as possible if there is a serious question about the candidate's suitability for ordained ministry.
