### Fourth Annual Feast of Corpus Christi Food Collection For The Poor

Each summer our Catholic Charities Food Pantries experience severe shortages due to less food donations coming in over the summer and the greater need for food especially among children.

Hopefully, the Corpus Christi Food Collection For The Poor will alleviate the annual food shortage. Bishop Serratelli has authorized this Diocesan-wide food collection in all parishes on the **Feast of Corpus Christi on the weekend of June 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>.**

Unlike most food drives in which parishioners are given a list of items to collect, for this special drive each parish is asked to collect two specific items. The reason for this is to assure we have sufficient quantities of each item. St. Pius X Parish has been asked to provide **any kind of Canned Beans** and **Disinfectant Wipes (for example, Lysol or Clorox).**
